FOUNDATION HORSEMANSHIP

May 26 + 27 - Fee \$300

Groundwork essentials will lead to a partnership with your horse, on the ground and in the saddle.

ADVANCING YOUR HORSEMANSHIP

May 29 + 30 - Fee \$300

As riders we strive to be one with the horse, to build confidence in both horse & rider. We'll be working on Feel, Timing & Balance using leg and rein aids to promote lightness in our horses.

HORSEMANSHIP USED IN COW WORKING

Helping the horse & rider with the skills needed to move cattle safely & quietly. Learning the 'flight zone' of the cattle, how little it takes & how much it takes to move them. Working cattle through obstacles 1 at a time, or loading one in a trailer!

This clinic is for riders that are pre-approved by Bob King ONLY! All saddle horns **must** be wrapped with either mule hide or latigo wraps!! Ropers will work on more difficult loops and methods to take cattle down for doctoring. Come ready to rope!!
